HIGH CARD FLUSH

High Card Flush is played using one standard 52-card deck. At the beginning of each game, the player places a standard High Card Flush Ante wager and may optionally place a Flush, Straight Flush and/or High Card Flush Progressive wager. Each player and the dealer then receive seven cards.

The High Card Flush Progressive pays against a paytable if the player is able to create a qualifying hand using their seven cards, even if the player folded their hand on the Ante/Raise wager. Additionally, paytables PT-BJS-HCF-SF-E01, PT-BJS-HCF-SF-E02, and PT-BJS-HCF-SF-E03 may also award a fixed Envy pay to other wagering players. To qualify for an Envy pay, at least one player must win the top progressive award. All other players who have placed the progressive wager, but have not received the top progressive award, will receive the listed Envy pay.
