## Jackpot Blackjack

## Rules of Play

Jackpot Blackjack is a variation of Blackjack that offers an optional "Jackpot Ante" and Jacks or Better side wagers that is played with six or eight standard decks of 52 cards.

To begin, the player must make the standard Blackjack wager and may also make a Jackpot Ante or Jacks or Better side wager. The Blackjack wager must be equal or greater than the Jackpot Ante.

The Jackpot Ante side wager pays even money if the player wins their Blackjack hand. If the Blackjack hand results in a tie or loss, the Jackpot Ante side wager is lost. If the player splits hands, the first hand's result is used to determine the outcome of the Jackpot Ante side wager.

In addition to this pay, the Jackpot Ante side wager also pays for a three card poker hand formed by using the player's initial two cards and the dealer's initial up-card.

<sup>\*</sup>If the progressive option is used, the Jackpot Ante side wager is a fixed amount determined by the casino. All progressive payouts are rounded up to the nearest dollar.

The Jacks or Better side wager is resolved using the player's initial two cards and the dealer's initial up-card to form a three card poker hand. The Jacks or Better side wager pays odds according to the paytable below.

Outcomes	Pay Table	
Three Fives	60 to 1	
Straight Flush	40 to 1	
Three of a Kind	30 to 1	
Straight	6 to 1	
Flush	4 to 1	
Pair of Jacks or Better	2 to 1	

Note: The player's Jackpot Ante wager is only returned to them when the player wins on the standard Blackjack game. The Jackpot Ante wager is not returned when the player has a winning three card poker hand.
