Matrix Blackjack

Rules of Play

Matrix Blackjack may be played using one, two, four, six or eight standard 52 card decks. All house rules apply to the standard game of Blackjack.

To begin, players must place a standard Blackjack wager and the optional Matrix Blackjack side wager. Blackjack is dealt per house rules.

If the player is dealt a blackjack in their first two cards, the side wager wins. Otherwise, the Matrix Blackjack side wager is lost.

The Matrix Blackjack side wager pays odds based on the player blackjack and the bonus hand, where the winning outcome intersects, on a matrix paytable. The bonus hand is the first two cards dealt to the dealer.
