

Mississippi Stud with Side Bet Low Hand Bonus

Rules of Play

Overview

Mississippi Stud with Side Bet Low Hand Bonus is a variant of Mississippi Stud which offers the optional Low Hand Bonus side bet. Players attempt to form the best hand from their 2 cards and the 3 community cards based on a payable, and do not compete against the dealer or other players.

To begin, players make an ante, make any other available side bets, and place an optional Low Hand Bonus side bet. The dealer then resolves the base game wagers according to house procedure for Mississippi Stud. The dealer pays according to the posted paytables for the base game wagers and for any side wagers, including the Low Hand Bonus side wager. All winning bets receive the same payouts according to the paytables.

The Low Hand Bonus side bet applies to the player's 5-card hand ONLY. The player's Low Hand Bonus wager wins if their 5-card hand contains less than a pair and their highest card is a Jack or lower. Aces are always considered high. If the player has placed a wager on the Low Hand Bonus side bet and folds, the dealer will collect the original Mississippi Stud wager(s) and place the folded cards under the player's Low Hand Bonus side bet (card placement is subject to house discretion). See the payable for payouts.

Low Hand Bonus Paytable PT01

| Hand | Payout |
|-----------|----------|
| 7 high | 100 to 1 |
| 8 high | 50 to 1 |
| 9 high | 15 to 1 |
| 10 high | 5 to 1 |
| Jack high | 1 to 1 |
