

RULES OF PLAY:

Pair Plus is an optional bonus wager for Baccarat. Players bet that either the Player hand or the Banker hand will contain a pair in its first two cards.

If bettors win, they have a choice:

- 1. Take the proceeds from the wager; or
- 2. Place any amount of the proceeds on:
 - a. The Player bet
 - b. The Banker bet
 - c. The Tie bet

Rules and Dealing Procedures

- 1. Players must make a main baccarat wager, they may also make the Pair Plus wager. They may bet on either the Player hand, the Banker hand, or both. The dealer then follows house procedures for baccarat.
- 2. The Pair Plus wagers are based on the first two cards of the Player hand or the first two cards in the Banker hand.
- 3. The Pair Plus wager pay 6 to 1.

Note: Pairs are exact-rank cards only. Jack-King is not a pair; King-King and Jack-Jack are.

- 4. If bettors win, the dealer will ask them if they want their proceeds refunded or added to any of the three standard wagers:
 - a. Player
 - b. Banker
 - c. Tie
- 5. The dealer then resumes the game.
