PROSPERITY 3 PICTURES

SUMMARY:

Prosperity 3 Pictures is a 3 card game where the player uses 3 cards to outrank the dealer's hand.

The game of Prosperity 3 Pictures uses 1 deck consisting of fifty-two (52) cards.

The rules and payouts are described below:

How to play

To begin, players must place a primary wager. Players may also wager on the optional Tie, Player Prosperity Pictures, Dealer Prosperity Pictures and/or Picture Perfect side wagers.

Each player and the dealer will receive three cards face down.

Each player and the dealer then reveal their three card hands.

The player's hand is compared to the dealer's hand to determine if each player wins, loses or ties, according to the hand ranks as follows:

- Three 'Picture' cards (King, Queen, Jack) of any combination and suit is the highest ranking hand, i.e., KKQ is equal to QQJ, which is equal to KJJ.
- Hands that are not three 'Picture' cards are determined based on their point total from zero to nine, as in Baccarat. Only the second digit of a hand total is counted and as a result the highest possible point total is nine, i.e. K, 7, 9 equals a point total of 6.
- When the player and the dealer have the same point total, the hand with the most 'Picture' cards wins.

Outcome	Paytable – Primary Wager
Player wins with Six Points	1 to 2
Player wins with Other Points	1 to 1
Player Ties	Push
Player Loses	Loss

THE VENETIAN® THE PALAZZO®

The **Tie** side wager wins if the player's hand point total is equal to the dealer's hand point total. When the player and the dealer receive the same three cards, regardless of suit, it is considered a Perfect Tie. The Tie side wager paytable is as follows:

Outcome	Paytable
Perfect Tie	400 to 1
Tie	10 to 1
Others	Lose

The **Prosperity Pictures** side wager wins if the below combination of cards are dealt to the Player's or Dealer's hand. The side wager loses with any other outcome.

Winning Bet	Pays
"Three Kings"	250 to 1
"Three Queens"	250 to 1
"Three Jacks"	250 to 1
"Three Mixed Pictures"	25 to 1
"Any Picture Pair"	15 to 1

The **Picture Perfect** side wager wins if one or more 'Picture' cards in the player's hand matches the 'Picture' cards in the dealer's hand. The number of matching cards is determined by the corresponding number of 'Picture' cards in both the player and dealer's hands. The side wager loses with any other outcome.

Winning Bet	Pays
1 Matching Picture card	5 to 1
2 Matching Picture cards	100 to 1
3 Matching Picture cards	500 to 1

^{*} Each "Picture" card in the Player's hand can only be used to match one "Picture" card in the Dealer's hand. e.g. if a Player's hand had contained J, 9 and 7 while the Dealer's hand had contained J, J and 6, there is only 1 matching "Picture" card.
