Modification Description

This modification adds the *Heads Up Hold'em Progressive* to *Ricochet Poker*. This progressive is intended to be used:

- As a standalone progressive on a single Ricochet Poker game.
- To link multiple Ricochet Poker games to a single progressive jackpot.
- To link Ricochet Poker games with other approved games that contain the Heads Up Hold'em Progressive (e.g., Heads Up Hold'em) to a single progressive jackpot.

Optional Bonus Wagers

Operators choose which optional bonus wager(s) they will offer and all minimum and maximum wagering limits.

Heads Up Hold'em Progressive

Players wager that their best 5-card hand, out of the 7 cards formed by the player's first 2 cards and the dealer's 5 cards, will achieve a winning event based on the corresponding paytable in Appendix A. Certain hands require a specific 5-card combination, such as using only the dealer's hand or the player's first 2 cards and the dealer's first 3 cards.

Notes:

- 1. All pays are "for 1." The jackpot wager is not returned.
- 2. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
- 3. Flopped refers to hands created from the player's first 2 cards and the dealer's first 3 cards only, as is the case for the Flopped Royal Flush (Suit Specific), Flopped Royal Flush, and the Flopped Straight Flush hands. The Dealer's Royal Flush refers to the hand created from the dealer's 5-card hand only. All other hands use the player's first 2 cards and the dealer's 5 cards to create the best 5-card hand.
- 4. The Flopped Royal Flush (Suit Specific) hand will be of a pre-determined suit (chosen by the operator) and posted on the paytable displayed on the TableVision.
- The hands labeled Three-of-a-Kind and Four-of-a-Kind are also known as Trips and Quads, respectively, as the terms are interchangeable and left to operator discretion.
- To qualify for an Envy pay, at least one player must win a qualifying progressive award. All other players who had
 placed a progressive wager in that round will receive the listed Envy pay. Players cannot receive an Envy pay on their
 own hand.
- 7. The above paytables are based off a \$1 wager. If the progressive is configured with a different base wagering unit, the seed/reseed, player pays, and Envy pays should be multiplied accordingly.
