

Royal 9 Baccarat Progressive w/STAX

Rules and Procedures

RULES OF PLAY

- 1. Players wager on the traditional baccarat wagers. In addition, they may place a Stax side bet on the optional Royal 9 Bonus bet.
- 2. In order to win on the STAX side bet:
 - a. Players must have a triggering hand. See posted paytable!
- 3. The dealer will deal the base game as per the dealing procedures.
 - a. The dealer will then settle traditional baccarat wagers, before settling the optional bets.
 - b. The dealer will then determine if any player has a triggering STAX hand.
 - c. If a player has a triggering hand, the Dealer will resolve and pay the Player the denomination/prize won on the STAX signage.
 - d. If there are no triggering hand for STAX, then the game continues according the house rules of the game
- 4. If any player has made a Royal 9 posted hand then they will be awarded the payout.
- 5. If no STAX side bets are made, then the game plays as normal and the dealer does not have to use the interface.

The 1.50% listed for the reserve increment is the minimum reserve increment. The operator can configure it to a higher amount, up to 6.00%. Whatever amount is added to the reserve increment rate will be subtracted from the main increment rate.
