## Rules:

Played with 6 Spanish Decks\*.

Double Down on any total on any number of cards including after splitting.

Split: Resplit to make 4 hands, hitting and doubling on 2 or more cards allowed.

Split: Resplit aces to make 4 hands, hitting and doubling on 2 or more cards allowed.

Natural pays 3/2. Player natural beats dealer natural.

Ties: Break even except, Players win on 21 when dealer has 21 in 3 or more cards.

## **BONUS 21 PAYOFFS:**

5 card 21	pays 3/2
6 card 21	pays 2-1
7+ card 21	pays 3-1
6-7-8 mixed suits	pays 3/2
6-7-8 same suit	pays 2-1
6-7-8 all spades	pays 3-1
7-7-7 mixed suits	pays 3/2
7-7-7 same suit	pays 2-1
7-7-7 all spades	pays 3-1

Dealer hits soft 17.

Insurance allowed.

Surrender on first 2 cards. Ace: late 10: late.

Double Down Rescue. Player after doubling and having a total of 12-16 may take back the doubled portion of the bet by taking one additional card,
