## THREE CARD PRIME

Three Card Prime is a played using a standard 52-card deck of cards. To begin, players must make a mandatory Ante wager to receive three cards which are used to form a higher poker hand than the dealer's three cards. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

The Mini-Royal Progressive is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a paytable if they are able to create a qualifying hand with their three hole cards.

## Notes:

- 1. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
- 2. The highest result in the paytable awards 100% of the progressive.
- 3. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
- 4. Operators may choose to offer Three Card Prime with or without this wager.
- 5. All pays are "X for 1."
- 6. Mini Royal (Suit Specific) means the player's Mini Royal hand must be of a predetermined specific suit. Mini Royal hands of other suits are awarded the Mini Royal (Other) payout.
- If the progressive is configured with a different wager amount, all seed/reseed values and player pays should be multiplied accordingly.

## **ALL 6 BONUS**

The All 6 Bonus is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a paytable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's three hole cards combined with the dealer's three cards. Otherwise, the All 6 Bonus side bet is lost.

- 2. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
- 3. The top two awards on Paytables 6 & 7 are fixed pays.
- 4. Operators may choose to offer Three Card Prime with or without this wager.

All other aspects of the standard game of Three Card Prime remain unchanged.
