Game Description

Triple Luck is an optional bonus wager for standard Blackjack and Blackjack variant games using 1, 2, 4, 6, or 8 standard 52-card decks. Players win if their three-card hand, formed by their first two cards and the dealer's up-card, achieve a winning event based on the corresponding paytable. The outcome of the Triple Luck wager is not dependent on the base game's outcome.

Rules of Play

- 1. To begin each round, players must place a primary Blackjack (base game) wager and may place an optional *Triple Luck* wager.
- 2. After all wagers are placed, each player receives two cards face-up and the dealer receives one card face-up and one card face-down, according to standard dealing procedures.
- 3. The dealer then reconciles all *Triple Luck* wagers based on the three-card hand, formed by the player's first two cards and the dealer's up-card. Winning wagers will be paid based on the corresponding paytable.
- 4. The primary game now continues until the round is completed, according to standard procedures.
