## Two Card Joker Poker Super Flush

## Rules of Play

Two Card Joker Poker Super Flush is a house banked poker game played using one standard 52 card deck plus two Jokers. Each card is ranked according to its poker face value (i.e., two, three, four, etc., up to Ace) while all suits are equivalent. The hand rankings are somewhat different compared to traditional poker. Jokers are only used to complete pairs.

Examples of hand rankings are as follows:

Example			
Joker, Joker			
Ace of Hearts, King of Hearts			
Jack of Clubs, 10 of Clubs			
5 of Hearts, 4 of Diamonds			
King of Hearts, King of Clubs or 5 of Spades, Joker			
Queen of Clubs, 10 of Clubs			
Queen of Hearts, 5 of Spades			

To begin, players make an Ante wager and may also place optional Pair Up and/or Super Flush Bonus side wagers. The player and the dealer then receive two cards.

Players review their cards and decide to either Fold and lose their Ante wager, or play, by making a Call wager equal to the amount of their Ante wager.

After decisions have been made, the dealer settles all remaining wagers. The dealer must qualify with a Queen High or better.

If the dealer does not qualify, the player's Ante wager is paid even money and the Call wager is pushed. If the dealer does qualify, and has a higher two-card poker ranking hand, the player loses both the Ante and Call wagers.

If the dealer does qualify, and the hands tie, both the Ante and Call wagers push.

If the dealer does qualify, and has a lower two-card poker ranking hand, the player is paid even money on the Ante and the Call wager is paid according to the following paytable:
