# World Poker Tour Heads Up Hold'em

World Poker Tour (WPT) Heads Up Hold'em is a Texas Hold'em variation played using a standard deck of 52 cards. To begin, players must make the mandatory Ante and Odds wagers, to receive two cards which are combined with five community cards. Players form their best five card poker hand against the dealer's five card poker hand. Additionally, players may place any optional side wagers made available.

WPT Heads Up Hold'em Progressive is an optional progressive side bet. Players are paid against a paytable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's two hole cards combined with the five-card community board.

- 4. After 100% payouts are awarded, the meter is reseeded with the full contents of the reserve pot-
- 5. Operators may choose to post a maximum aggregate.
- 6. Operators may choose to offer Head's Up Hold'em with or without this wager.

#### Notes:

- 1. Seed value and payout must scale with wager size if configured as more than \$1.
- 2. Progressive increments are based on the progressive wager, not the primary wager.

## **ALL-SIX BONUS**

The All-Six Bonus is an optional side bet. Players are paid against a paytable if they are able to create a qualifying hand that uses the player's two hole cards combined with the four All-Six community cards. Otherwise, the All-Six Bonus side bet is lost. The dealer will draw four All-Six cards prior to dealing the standard game or after and place them in the designated area of the layout.
