ZooBac

Rules of Play

ZooBac is a variation to the standard game of Baccarat played using eight decks of 52 cards. There is no commission and the Banker pushes on winning three card totals of 8. Additionally, ZooBac offers four optional side wagers: Rabbit Bet, Tiger Bet, Monkey Bet and Zoo Bet.

Game Rules

- 1. Each player may place the base game wagers and additionally place a wager on the Rabbit, Tiger, Monkey or Zoo side bets. (Licensee discretion to make base game wager mandatory.)
- 2. Once all bets are placed, the game is dealt following traditional Baccarat rules and procedures.
- 3. The hand is then completed following standard Baccarat drawing rules for Player and Banker.
- 4. After the Baccarat hand is finished, each bet is resolved.
- 5. Winning Player or Banker bets are paid even money. Losing bets are taken.
- No commission is taken on winning Banker bets. If the Banker wins with a three-card total of 8
 then all Banker bets push.
- 7. Rabbit Bet pays 25 to 1 when the Player wins with a three-card hand totaling 7. If the Rabbit bet wins and the Banker hand total is 0, the bet pays 75 to 1.
- 8. Tiger Bet pays 25 to 1 when the Banker wins with a three-card hand totaling 8. If the Tiger bet wins and the Player hand total is 0, the bet pays 75 to 1.
- 9. Monkey Bet pays (Licensee discretion to choose either 150 to 1 or 140 to 1) when the hand ends in a 0 to 0 tie.
- 10. The Zoo Bet pays at the following odds if the Rabbit, Tiger or Monkey bets win:
 - a. If the Rabbit bet wins, the Zoo bet pays 10 to 1. If the Rabbit bet wins and the Banker hand totals 0, the Zoo bet pays 30 to 1.
 - b. If the Tiger bet wins, the Zoo bet pays 10 to 1. If the Tiger bet wins and the Player hand totals 0, the Zoo bet pays 30 to 1.
 - c. If the Monkey bet wins, the Zoo bet pays 30 to 1.
