FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That the COMMISSION has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to NRS 463.310(3) and 463.337.

- 2. That Respondent, TERESA SERRANO, is registered with the Board as a gaming employee and, as such, is subject to the provisions of the Nevada Gaming Control Act and the Regulations of the COMMISSION.
- 3. That on or about December 25, 2017, Respondent was a registered gaming employee employed by and working as a cage cashier at the Hard Rock Hotel and Casino.
- 4. That the Las Vegas Sands, LLC, dba Venetian Resort Hotel Casino/Palazzo Resort Hotel Casino (Venetian), is a Nevada licensed gaming establishment holding a nonrestricted gaming license.
- 5. That on or about December 25, 2017, Respondent redeemed several TITO vouchers that were provided to her by her husband, Romeo Serrano, using a Venetian TITO redemption kiosk.
- 6. After redeeming the TITO vouchers, Respondent walked away from the TITO redemption kiosk with the resulting cash.
- 7. The TITO vouchers redeemed by Respondent were improperly obtained by Respondent's husband, Romeo Serrano, during his employment at the Venetian as a slot manager.
- 8. Respondent knew that her husband, Romeo Serrano, found the TITO vouchers on the Venetian gaming floor.
- 9. Board agents discovered two (2) stacks of U.S. currency in the amounts of \$1,052.00 and \$879.00 in Respondent's purse that equate to the dollar amount of TITO vouchers redeemed by Respondent on December 25, 2017.
- 10. Respondent knew that the TITO vouchers redeemed by her on December 25, 2017 were not the property of Respondent or her husband.
- 11. On or about May 2, 2018, Respondent signed a Guilty Plea Agreement whereby she agreed to plead guilty to Conspiracy to Commit Theft arising from her unlawful redemption of a \$921.00 TITO voucher on December 25, 2017 belonging to the Venetian.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW 1 12. That pursuant to NRS 463.337(2): 2 The Commission may revoke the 3 registration of a gaming employee if the Commission finds, after a hearing as provided in 4 NRS 463.310 and 463.312 to 463.3145, inclusive, that the gaming employee . . . , subsequent to being 5 registered as a gaming employee: 6 7 (d) Committed, attempted or conspired to 8 commit larceny or embezzlement against a gaming licensee or upon the premises of a licensed gaming 9 establishment. 13.
