STIPULATION AND ORDER RE: BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND HEARING DATE ON RESPONDENT'S FORTHCOMING MOTION TO DISMISS

WHEREAS, the Nevada Gaming Control Board (the "Board") filed the above-captioned matter on October 14, 2019;

WHEREAS, counsel for Respondent Stephen A. Wynn ("Mr. Wynn") agreed to accept service of the Complaint, and actually accepted service on October 25, 2019;

WHEREAS, Mr. Wynn's counsel advised the Board's counsel of their intent to seek dismissal of the Complaint based on a lack of subject matter jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the parties' respective counsel agree it will promote economy and efficiency to address the jurisdictional question before proceeding to a substantive hearing in this matter, and

that such economy and efficiency can best be achieved through an agreed-upon briefing schedule and proposed hearing date as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties, through their respective counsel of record as follows:

- 1. Mr. Wynn will file his forthcoming Motion to Dismiss on or before November 14, 2019. Mr. Wynn shall serve Board counsel electronically by November 14, and shall file a hard copy with the Nevada Gaming Commission (the "Commission") no later than November 15, 2019;
- 2. The Board shall file its Response to the Motion to Dismiss on or before November 27, 2019. The Board shall serve Mr. Wynn's counsel electronically and file with Commission by 12:00 p.m. noon on November 27;
- 3. Mr. Wynn shall file his Reply on or before December 9, 2019. Mr. Wynn shall serve Board counsel electronically by December 9, and shall file a hard copy with the Commission no later than December 10, 2019;
- 4. Subject to the Commission's discretion, the parties propose that a hearing be held on Mr. Wynn's Motion to Dismiss on December 19, 2019; and
- 5. During the pendency of Mr. Wynn's Motion to Dismiss, all other proceedings in this action shall be stayed. Each party shall have the right as provided in NRS Chapter 463 to seek a further stay from the Commission and from the District Court should either party file a petition for judicial review after the Commission issues its written decision on the Motion to Dismiss. If the Commission denies the Motion to Dismiss, and Mr. Wynn opts not to seek judicial review, then
