JOINT STIPULATION FOR SETTLEMENT AND ORDER

The State of Nevada, on relation of its NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD (BOARD), filed and served Complaints in NGC Case No. 20-07 against SB GAMING, LLC, dba SAHARA LAS VEGAS, and in NGC Case No. 20-09 against MEI-GSR HOLDINGS, LLC, dba GRAND SIERRA RESORT, RESPONDENTS herein, alleging certain violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act and Regulations of the Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission or NGC).

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED to by the BOARD and RESPONDENTS that the Complaints, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, filed against RESPONDENTS in the above-entitled cases, shall be settled on the following terms and conditions:

RESPONDENTS do not admit nor deny that the factual allegations set forth in 1. the Complaints, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, are true and correct, but $_{28} \parallel$

enter into this Joint Stipulation for Settlement and Order (Stipulation for Settlement) because they believe the BOARD could meet its burden of proof if these matters were to proceed to evidentiary hearings before the Commission.

- 2. RESPONDENTS fully understand and voluntarily waive the right to a public hearing on the charges and allegations set forth in the Complaints, the right to present and cross-examine witnesses, the right to a written decision on the merits of the Complaints, and the right to obtain judicial review of the Commission's decision.
- 3. RESPONDENTS agree to pay a fine in the amount of SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$75,000.00) electronically transferred to the *State of Nevada-Nevada Gaming Commission*. RESPONDENTS agree to pay one-half of the fine on or before the date this Stipulation for Settlement is accepted by the Commission and pay the remaining balance of the fine on or before October 24, 2020. Said payments shall be made by a method of electronic payment approved by the Tax and License Division of the BOARD pursuant to NRS 353.1467. Interest on the fine shall accrue pursuant to NRS 17.130 on any unpaid balance computed from the date the respective payments are due until payment of the fine, and any accrued interest, is made in full.
- 4. In consideration for the execution of this Stipulation for Settlement, RESPONDENTS for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharge the State of Nevada, the Commission, the BOARD, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents, and employees, in their individual and representative capacities, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, execution, claims, and demands whatsoever, known or unknown, in law and equity, that RESPONDENTS ever had, now have, may have, or claim to have against any and all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of, or by reason of, the investigation of the allegations of the Complaints filed in these disciplinary actions, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, or any matter relating thereto.

- 5. In further consideration for the execution of this Stipulation for Settlement, RESPONDENTS hereby indemnify and hold harmless the State of Nevada, the Commission, the BOARD, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents, and employees, in their individual and representative capacities, from any and all claims, suits, and actions brought against the persons named in this paragraph by reason of the investigation of the allegations in the Complaints filed in these disciplinary actions, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, and all other matters relating thereto, and against any and all expenses, damages, charges, and costs, including court costs and attorney fees, which have been or may be sustained by the persons and entities named in this paragraph as a result of said claims, suits, and actions.
- 6. RESPONDENTS enter into this Stipulation for Settlement freely and voluntarily and acknowledge that this Stipulation for Settlement is not the product of force, threats, or any other form of coercion or duress, but is the product of discussions between RESPONDENTS and the attorney for the BOARD.
- 7. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD acknowledge that this Stipulation for Settlement is made to avoid litigation and economize resources.
- 8. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD recognize and agree that the Commission has the sole and absolute discretion to determine whether to accept this Stipulation for Settlement.
- 9. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD hereby waive any right they may have to challenge the impartiality of the Commission to hear the above-entitled cases on the matters embraced in the Complaints, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, if the Commission determines not to accept this Stipulation for Settlement.
- 10. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD agree and understand that if the Commission does not accept this Stipulation for Settlement, it shall be withdrawn as null and void and RESPONDENTS' admissions, if any, that certain violations of the Nevada Gaming Control Act or the regulations adopted thereunder had occurred shall be withdrawn.

- 11. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD agree and understand that this Stipulation for Settlement is intended to operate as full and final settlement of the Complaints filed against RESPONDENTS in the above-entitled disciplinary cases, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09.
- 12. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD agree and understand that any oral representations are superseded by this Stipulation for Settlement and that only those terms memorialized in writing herein shall be effective.
- 13. RESPONDENTS agree and understand that, although this Stipulation for Settlement, if approved by the Commission, will settle the Complaints filed in the above-entitled disciplinary cases, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, the allegations contained in the Complaints and the terms of this Stipulation for Settlement may be considered by the BOARD or Commission with regards to any and all applications filed by RESPONDENTS with the BOARD in the future, or that are currently pending before the BOARD or Commission, and with regard to any future disciplinary action that may be brought against the RESPONDENTS.
- 14. RESPONDENTS and the BOARD shall each bear their own costs incurred in these disciplinary actions, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09, including, but not limited to, attorney costs, if any.
- 15. RESPONDENTS, by executing this Stipulation for Settlement, affirmatively waive all notice required by law for these matters including, but not limited to, notice concerning consideration of the character or misconduct of a person (Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 241.033), notice concerning consideration of administrative action against a person (NRS 241.034), and notice concerning hearings before the Commission (NRS 463.312). Regardless of this waiver of the applicable legal notice requirements, the BOARD or Commission will attempt to provide reasonable notice of the time and place of any hearing relating to these disciplinary actions, NGC Case No. 20-07 and NGC Case No. 20-09.
