Litigation Decision Delegation

THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission) on Thursday, June 23, 2022, for the purpose of deciding whether to delegate litigation decisions to the Commission Chair. Pursuant to NRS 241.0357, the Commission hereby delegates authority to the Commission Chair to make any decision regarding litigation concerning any action or proceeding in which the Commission or any member or employee of the Commission is a party in an official capacity or participates or intervenes in an official capacity. This delegation is subject to the following limitations:

- 1. The Commission Chair must provide advance notice of any anticipated litigation decision to the entire Commission;
- 2. The Commission may, upon a majority vote in a specific case, temporarily abrogate the general delegation made by this Order; and
- 3. Any specific decision of the Commission Chair made pursuant to the general delegation made by this Order is subject to consideration by the entire Commission upon the request of any Commissioner. Should a Commissioner request a specific decision made by the Commission Chair be subject to consideration by the entire Commission, such item will be placed on the next available Commission agenda.
