The Claimant, WILLIAM HILL U.S. HOLDCO, INC. (WILLIAM HILL), and the NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD (BOARD) hereby stipulate and agree that the Claim for Refund in Case No. 21-01-RTR shall be settled on the following terms:

- 1. On or about December 9, 2021, WILLIAM HILL filed with the Nevada Gaming Commission a Claim for Refund for gross gaming revenue taxes based on over-reported interactive gaming revenue for July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021 pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 463.387 and Nev. Gaming Comm'n. Reg. 6.180.
- 2. The BOARD reviewed the Claim for Refund and confirmed that WILLIAM HILL over-reported interactive gross gaming revenue for on-line poker tournaments during the relevant period. The result is an over-payment of gross gaming revenue taxes for such period in the amount of \$1,695,798.71.
- 3. The BOARD agrees to refund, and WILLIAM HILL agrees to accept, as full and final settlement of the Claim for Refund, in Case No. 21-01-RTR, ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED NINETY FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY EIGHT DOLLARS AND SEVENTY ONE CENTS (\$1,695,798.71) plus interest in the amount of \$63,714.11 through February 17, 2020, for a total of ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS AND EIGHTY TWO CENTS (\$1,759,512.82), with interest continuing to accrue at \$121.96 for each day

thereafter that the claim remains unpaid.

- 4. This settlement is made for the purposes of avoiding litigation and economizing resources and does not constitute an admission of liability on the part of the BOARD or WILLIAM HILL, nor shall it operate or be construed as any precedent for the validity or invalidity of any legal position taken in this matter by either party. This settlement is made exclusively between the BOARD and WILLIAM HILL and no licensee may rely upon it for any purpose.
- 5. WILLIAM HILL fully understands and voluntarily waives any right it may have to a public hearing on the Claim for Refund, in Case No. 21-01-RTR, and its right to pursue judicial review of the Claim for Refund in state district court or otherwise contest this matter in any court of competent jurisdiction.
- 6. WILLIAM HILL, for itself, its heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby releases, dismisses, and forever discharges the State of Nevada, the Nevada Gaming Commission, the Nevada Gaming Control Board, the Nevada Attorney General and each of their members, agents, and employees in their individual and representative capacities from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, executions, claims, and demands whatsoever known or unknown, in law and equity, that WILLIAM HILL ever had, now has, may have, or claims to have against any and all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of, or by reason of, this Claim for Refund, Case No. 21-01-RTR, or any other matter relating thereto.
- 7. WILLIAM HILL, for itself, its heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby indemnifies and holds harmless the State of Nevada, the Nevada Gaming Commission, the Nevada Gaming Control Board, the Nevada Attorney General, and each of their members, agents, and employees in their individual and representative capacities against any and all claims, suits, actions, debts, damages, costs, charges, and expenses, including court costs and attorney's fees, and against all liability, losses, and damages of any nature whatsoever that the persons and entities named in this paragraph shall or

may have at any time sustain or be put to by reason of this Claim for Refund, Case No. 21-01-RTR, or any other matter relating thereto.

- 8. WILLIAM HILL enters into this Stipulation freely and voluntarily. WILLIAM HILL confirms that this settlement is not a result of force, threats, or any other type of coercion or duress, but is the product of negotiations between representatives of WILLIAM HILL and the BOARD.
- 9. WILLIAM HILL affirmatively represents that if WILLIAM HILL, this Stipulation and Order, and/or any amounts distributed under this Stipulation and Order are subject to, or will become subject to, the jurisdiction of any bankruptcy court that the bankruptcy court's approval is not necessary for this Stipulation and Order to become effective, or the bankruptcy court has already approved this Stipulation and Order. WILLIAM HILL further affirmatively represents that any amounts distributed under this Stipulation and Order may be paid directly to WILLIAM HILL, and WILLIAM HILL will distribute these amounts in accordance with any bankruptcy court order or bankruptcy court approved bankruptcy plan directing how these amounts shall be distributed.
- 10. WILLIAM HILL and the BOARD recognize and agree that the Nevada Gaming Commission has the sole and absolute discretion to determine whether to accept this Stipulation for Settlement. WILLIAM HILL and the BOARD hereby waive any right they may have to challenge the impartiality of the Nevada Gaming Commission to hear and consider the facts and matters embraced in the Claim for Refund, Case No. 21-01-RTR, in the event the Nevada Gaming Commission does not accept this Stipulation for Settlement.
